Sewage Systems

<p><input type="checkbox"/> Subsurface Sewage Permit- New</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A permit is required for new systems or new location of a system. • A review of soil types is made at proposed location for actual septic system • Sizing of the drainfield and septic tank is determined. • Permit approval depends on the following: the predicted maximum daily sewage flow; house size and location; well / spring location; surface water locations; depth to groundwater on limiting layers; changes to native soil (road cuts, grading, benching); distance to neighboring structures (wells, buildings, drainfields); proposed land use; soil type; other issues of concern. • Permits to construct a septic system are not granted until all such issues are addressed and / or submitted in writing as part of the plot plan / permit application and found to be consistent with current regulations. • Permit applications are for 1 year (No Renewal). • Septic Permits are valid one (1) year from date of issuance. • No partial refund is made if fieldwork is done but a permit cannot be approved. 	\$860
<p><input type="checkbox"/> Individual System Permit – Expansion</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For projects with an increase in flow that requires the existing drainfield to be expanded greater than 10% 	\$400
<p><input type="checkbox"/> Repair Permit</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Replacement of a failing system 	\$300
<p><input type="checkbox"/> Septic Tank, Vault Privy or Pit Privy Permit</p>	\$250
<p><input type="checkbox"/> Authorization to Connect</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Septic system installed and passed final inspection but construction of dwelling not commenced within one year of final inspection 	\$100
<p><input type="checkbox"/> Permit Renewal - (Must apply for renewal prior to expiration date)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1 year renewal (extends permit for an additional year from original issuance date) • No limit on number of renewal 	\$100

Central / Large Soil Absorption System

<p><input type="checkbox"/> Central / Large Soil Absorption System Review</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Data providing estimated wastewater flow volume 	\$150
<p><input type="checkbox"/> Permit</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Panhandle Health will confirm wastewater flow prior to fee acceptance. • Parcels to be served will be identified and any required easements will be in place prior to issuance of permit. • If residential, tank permits for each future dwelling will be needed prior to hook-up. 	\$2.50/per gallon of design daily flow
<p><input type="checkbox"/> Repair Permit</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Replacement of a failing system. 	\$400

Speculative Site Evaluation

<p><input type="checkbox"/> Speculative Site Evaluation</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Consists of a review of soil types on property. • Used for planning purposes only and does not constitute approval or disapproval of a site. • Fee can be applied to a septic permit if application is made within one year. 	\$50 per hole with \$500 minimum
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
