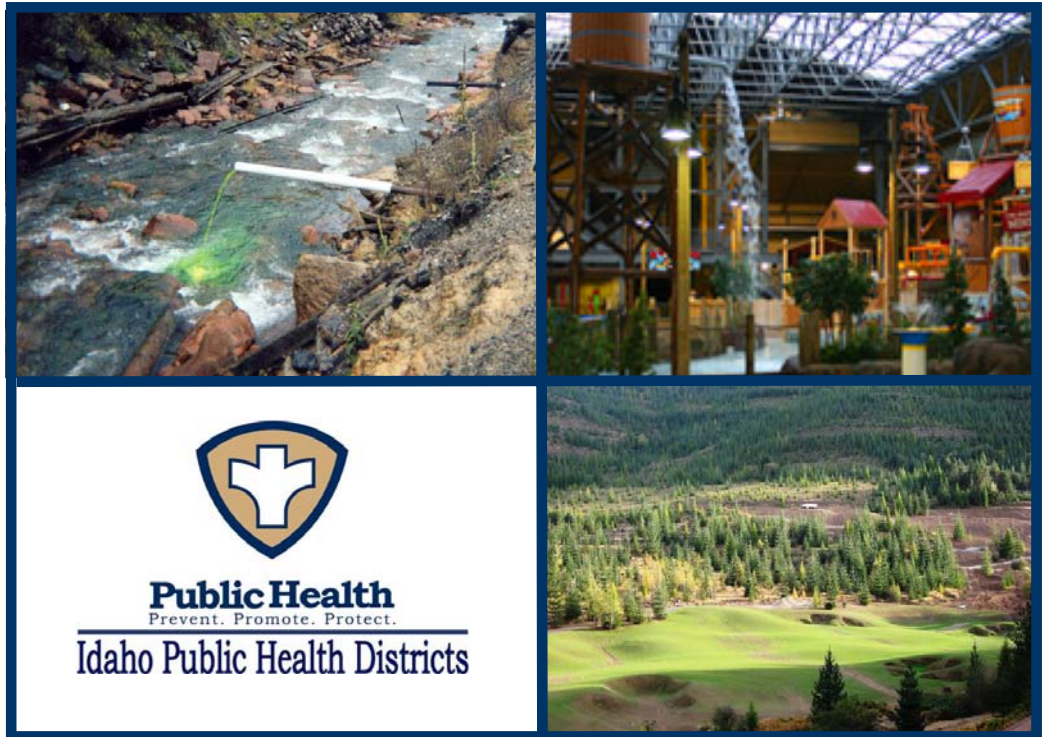

He also manages the Institutional Controls Program to ensure the integrity of clean soil and ensure that other protective barriers are in place throughout the Superfund site.
